Job Summary: Serves as Chief of Operations, the leader of the Operations Community of Practice (CoP) for the SWD region within the Programs Directorate of SWD. Has delegated authority and responsibility for oversight of the Operations and Maintenance programs of the Programs Directorate including Navigation, Regulatory, Natural Resources Management, Critical Project Security, Flood Risk Management, Water Supply and Hydropower. Provides technical direction and intermediate supervision over 4-6 engineering/scientific positions and 1-2 supervisory program managers. Also provides technical direction and higher-level supervision of 3-4 multi-disciplined professionals (engineers, scientists, program managers) performing Operations program work. Provides program quality assurance and advice to the Commander on regional Operations and Maintenance and Regulatory activities.

Exercises command and control for the Commander with regard to Operations and Maintenance and Regulatory Programs for subordinate districts.

Manages 500+ million-dollar Operations and Maintenance General and 17 million-dollar Regulatory regional programs for the Division.

Performs other duties as assigned.

Time in Grade Requirement: Applicants who have held a General Schedule (GS) position within the last 52 weeks must have 52 weeks of Federal service at the next lower grade or equivalent (GS-14). Applicant must be an eligible GS-14 or GS-15 or have formerly held a permanent GS-14 position in the competitive service and possess leadership/managerial skills in Operations and Regulatory Management.
