You must obtain your supervisor's concurrence to your availability for this below mentioned timeframe of up to 120 days. Selection will be made soon after the closing date and the start date will be on or about **19 June 2022**. The position will be filled as a Temporary Promotion or Temporary Reassignment NTE 120 Days. Selection is dependent upon qualifications being reviewed and approved by CPAC.

Location: This position will be located at the Kansas City District Office. NOTE: The selected candidate may be able to work virtually from their current location through the duration of the assignment with periodic trips to the District Office and various field sites for meetings and coordination efforts.

TDY: TDY expenses for travel to and from the District Office and meetings may be paid.

Area of Consideration: Any permanent civilian employees within the Corps of Engineers meeting qualifications and experience.

Major Duties: Works under the general supervision of the Chief, Natural Resource Management Section and serves as Environmental Compliance Coordinator for the district. Performs a variety of assignments involving all aspects of environmental compliance and sustainability program in the Kansas City District, representing NWK on calls with the HQ/NWD Environmental and Sustainability program managers. Responsibilities include technical support for environmental compliance, sustainability, and electric vehicle reporting, onsite inspections within NWK and assigned NWD external Environmental Compliance Assessment reviews and meeting ERGO, EPA, CERCLA, and RCRA standards as required; review of Real Estate outgranted interest requiring Environmental Condition of Property review for new, renewal, and 2023 Agricultural and Grazing Notice of Availability reviews; provide support and regular communication with the field and office staff; assist with planning efforts for NWK's Fall Park Manager Meeting.

Specialized Experience GS-11: One year of Specialized Experience equivalent to a GS-09 grade level that has equipped the applicant with experience in assisting leadership, project management, and support of the Operations & Management program.
